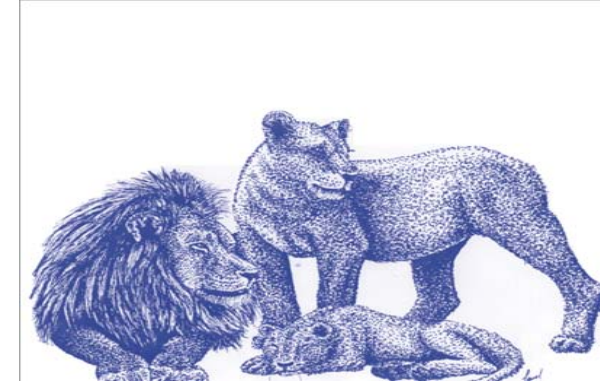

**Graduation Requirements**

Students must satisfy all course, credit, and testing requirements for at least one *Course of Study* in order to earn a diploma. The four *Courses of Study* offered are: College/University Prep, College Tech Prep, Career Prep, and Occupational Prep. Students in grades 9 and 10 and 11 must complete a graduation project. Students must earn at least four credits appropriate for a *Career Pathway* to include a second level course to meet the Career Prep and College Tech Prep *Courses of Study*. Leesville offers eight *Career Pathways*. Please visit our website at [leesville.org](http://leesville.org) for specific graduation requirements for each grade level.

**Class Rank**

Class rank is computed at the beginning, mid-year, third quarter, and end of the school year. Third quarter rank is used to determine Valedictorians, Salutatorians, and other senior honors. Rank is cumulative, includes grades 9-12, and transfer grades. It is based on a 4.0 scale with weighted grades awarded to advanced placement and honors. Courses are weighted as follows:
