Varsity Spirit Corporation d/b/a Spirit Xpress Cheerleading Release and Waiver

DEFINITIONS: As used below, "Varsity Spirit " shall mean Varsity Spirit Corporation, a Tennessee corporation, and its officers, directors, employees, agents, successors and assigns of each of the foregoing, d/b/a, Spirit Xpress Cheerleading, "Season" shall mean from June 1 of the current year to May 30 of the following calendar year. "Site" shall mean any entity on whose premises a camp or instructional session will occur in this season, and such entity's parent, subsidiary and other affiliated or related companies, and the officers, directors, employees, agents, members, successors and assigns of each of the foregoing; "Provider" shall mean the host or sponsoring entity of any training, instruction, practices (hereinafter "Camp") held in the season, and such host's parent, subsidiary and other affiliated or related companies, and the officers, directors, employees, agents, members, successors and assigns of each of the foregoing. "Child" shall mean any Minor participant, both in the masculine, feminine, singular and/or the plural as appropriate. "Parent" shall mean any individual whether by relation, adoption, authorization, or operation of law, has legal custody or appointed guardianship of said Minor.

VIGOROUS ACTIVITY: Cheerleading involves vigorous athletic activity and may include stunts, pyramids, gymnastics, jumps, and dance. Due to the nature of the activity, the possibility of injury up to and including death does exist as with any athletic activity. My child is physically fit to participate in this activity and no medical conditions exist which may compromise the safety or well being of my child or any other participant or staff member of the event.

I, in my own behalf and on behalf of Minor, further agree to release and to hold harmless Varsity Spirit, Varsity Spirit's Corporate Sponsors (hereinafter "Sponsors"), the Hosting site, (university, hotel, convention center, high school) on whose premises the Camp will occur (hereinafter the "Location"), the affiliates of Varsity Spirit and the Location, and the respective directors, officers, representatives, members, agents and employees of Varsity Spirit, Sponsors, the Location and their respective affiliates (hereinafter collectively "Releasees") from any and all liability whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise for any claim, judgment, loss, liability, cost and expenses (including, without limitations, attorney's fees and costs) arising out of or connected with the Camp, including any claim arising out of or connected with any illness or injury (minimal, serious, catastrophic and / or death) that Minor may incur or sustain during the Camp, all activities associated with the Camp and while traveling to and from the site for the Camp whether or not the Camp actually occurs. I further expressly agree to indemnify and hold harmless Releasees and Releasees' heirs, successors, assigns, executors and administrators against loss from any further claims, demands or actions that may subsequently be brought by Minor or by any other persons on the account of damages of any character resulting to Minor in any way from the foregoing activities. I further agree to reimburse and to make good to Releasees any loss or costs Releasees may have to pay as a result of any such action, claim, or demand.

PARENTAL CONSENT: I, in my own behalf and on behalf of Minor, hereby warrant that I have read this Participant Release and Waiver Form in its entirety and fully understand its contents. I, in my own behalf and on behalf of Minor, am aware that this Participant Release and Waiver Form releases Releasees from liability and contains an acknowledgement of my voluntary and knowing assumption of the risk of injury or illness. In order that my daughter/son may receive the necessary medical treatment in the event of any injury or illness, I hereby authorize **Varsity Spirit Corporation, Inc.** to obtain medical treatment for my child for such injury or illness during their participation at Camp, and also authorize the physician and/or hospital near the Camp site to perform treatment to any illness or injury to my child. I authorize payment for treatment, either personally or through our family health insurance. GENERAL CAMP RULES

1. Please leave valuables at home (rings, jewelry, etc.). Spirit Xpress Cheerleading will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
2. Contact a member of the Spirit Xpress Cheerleading management staff before seeking medical attention at a clinic or hospital (at camps where management staff is provided).
3. The use, consumption or possession of tobacco, alcohol, or other illegal substances is prohibited.
4. Hazing or initiations of any type is prohibited (this entails anything that may embarrass or cause an individual to stand out at camp).
5. If attending an overnight camp (resort or resident), all participants must follow housing rules: A) No running or unnecessary noise in the halls. B) All windows are to remain closed in the air-conditioned dorms/ resorts. In dorms / resorts without air-condition, windows may be left open, but screens must be left on. No leaning out of windows. No throwing anything out of windows. C) There will be no tumbling, horseplay, partner stunts or practicing in the dorm / resort. D) Any damage to the room will be charged to your group. Be sure to leave your room as clean as you found it. E) Some locations charge participants for lost keys. Please keep up with your keys. F) All participants must be in the building at 9:00 pm, on their floor by 10:00 pm, in the rooms by 10:30 pm (for bed check by Spirit Xpress staff) and in bed with lights out by 11:00 pm and remain there until morning. If an emergency occurs, participants should contact the Camp Manager immediately for assistance. G) No one of the opposite sex will be allowed in the sleeping rooms.
6. Participants will not ride in cars while at camp. Participants must walk with their squads / teams to all camp functions. If participants bring their car, they must park their car and turn keys over to the Camp manager (if applicable). Participants are not allowed to leave the "camp" premises.
