 - ❑ March- Second semester teachers input recommendations into SPAN for Freshmen and Sophomores
 - ❑ April-Counselors meet with Freshmen and Sophomores
 - ❑ May-Course Verification Forms sent home

Student Role

- Know what they need to graduate
 - Research what they need for post-secondary plans
 - Talk with their teachers
 - Talk with their parents
 - Talk with their counselors
 - Follow through with classes that have an application or audition
 - Make sure they have a “balance” of classes
 - Make sure they are content with their choices before they leave for the summer

Parent Role

- ❑ Be aware of the registration calendar, talk with your student before they choose their courses
 - ❑ Talk with teachers before the process begins
 - ❑ Talk with counselor, over phone or through email. Due to size of caseload, individual in-person conferences are not possible
 - ❑ Assist student in researching post-secondary plans
 - ❑ Make sure there is a balance
 - ❑ Make sure the student is content with their choices before they leave for summer

Counselor Role

- ❑ Refer to the Bottom of the Calendar
 - ❑ Counselors will meet with all Juniors individually during the month of March
 - ❑ Counselors will meet with all Sophomores and Freshmen in April
 - ❑ Counselor will adjust course selections after Verification forms are sent out
