



LRHS Scholarship Bulletin

March 2010

This monthly bulletin is not meant to be an all-inclusive list of scholarship information. It only contains information on scholarships that we have actually received at the school. It often does not contain college/university specific scholarships unless it is a college/university scholarship that requires a specific nomination from Leesville. Students are encouraged to look at the websites for the colleges they are applying to for specific scholarship information for that particular school.

If a scholarship requests that you must include a transcript with your application, you must do the following:

- Use your transcript release form on file in the Student Services' office to request an official transcript to be mailed to the address supplied in the scholarship information.
- The registrar can give you an unofficial transcript along with a letter stating that an official transcript will be mailed.
- You must pay for the transcript to be mailed if you have already used your three free transcript requests.
- **Do not bring your request to the registrar on or near the due date and expect it to be mailed by the deadline. You must allow 5-7 days for the transcript to be mailed.**

1. **Leesville PTSA Scholarships** - The PTSA is offering two \$500 scholarships to Leesville seniors. The criteria for both are listed below:

PTSA School Involvement Scholarship

- 2.5 or above weighted GPA
- School involvement
- One teacher recommendation
- Completion of an essay (topic is included on the application)

PTSA Academic Scholarship

- 3.7 (or above) weighted GPA
- School and community involvement
- One teacher recommendation
- Completion of an essay (topic is included on the application)

Applications for both scholarships are in the Student Services' Office, and completed materials must be returned to Mr. Greene by March 26, 2010.

2. **Raleigh/Wake Chapter North Carolina Central University Alumni Scholarship** - This scholarship is open to seniors who have been accepted and plan to attend NCCU, have at least a 2.5 GPA, and a 900 on the SAT. Applications are in the Student Services' Office, and the deadline to apply is March 31, 2010.
3. **Raleigh-Wake Chapter of the Winston-Salem State University Alumni Scholarship** - This scholarship is open to seniors who plan to attend Winston Salem State University, have at least a 2.7 GPA, and an 850 on the SAT. Applications are in the Student Services' Office, and the deadline to apply is April 1, 2010.
4. **American Association of Blacks in Energy (AABE) Scholarship** - This scholarship is open to African-American, Hispanic, and Native American seniors who plan to go to college and major in business, engineering, technology, mathematics, or physical science fields. Interested students must also have at least a 3.0 GPA in order to apply. Applications are available at www.AABE.org, and the deadline to apply is March 19, 2010.
5. **Maude P. McInnes Scholarship** - This scholarship is for seniors who plan to pursue a college degree in the Family Consumer Science area or a related field. Applications are in the Student Services' Office. An official transcript must be sent with the application, so students interested in

this scholarship should complete the application, obtain the needed recommendation letters, and turn all materials back to the Student Services office' by April 9, 2010.

6. **Junior Woman's Club of Raleigh Lynne Bedini Lewis Scholarship and Endowment Fund Scholarship** - These \$500 and \$2000 scholarships are open to seniors who are planning to continue their education. Applications for each scholarship are available in the Student Services' Office, and the deadline to apply for both is April 2, 2010.
7. **Pride Productions - Jerry Mohs Memorial Scholarship** - This \$1000 scholarship is open to LRHS seniors who have at least a 3.0 GPA, have plans to pursue a degree in some area of theatre, and previous theatre experience at LRHS. Applications can be obtained from either Ms. Catania or Ms. Wrayno. The deadline to return your applications to them is April 26, 2010.
8. **Carrols Corporation Burger King Community Scholarship** - This scholarship is open to any graduating senior. Applications are in the Student Services' Office, and the deadline to apply is April 1, 2010.
9. **North Carolina Bar Association Scholarship** - This award is for children of North Carolina law enforcement officers killed or permanently disabled in the line of duty. For further information e-mail Jacquelyn Terrell at jterrell@ncbar.org. The deadline to apply is April 1, 2010.
10. **Delta Tau Delta Fraternity** - This scholarship is open to any senior who has excelled in the area of academics, leadership, athletic activities, and community services. To learn more, go to <http://www.delts.org/about/committed.html>. The deadline to apply is March 31, 2010.

The scholarships listed below were on the February Bulletin, but are still available.

1. **Michelle B. Vitale Memorial Scholarship** - The Michelle B. Vitale Scholarship Trust is proud to offer an annual scholarship in memory of Michelle B. Vitale, a former teacher at Leesville Road High School. Ms. Vitale dedicated her life to working with children of all ages. The criteria for the \$1000 scholarship are:
 - Plans for further education as a full-time student
 - **Plans to pursue a degree in Education**
 - Current GPA of 3.0 or higher
 - Two letters of recommendation from LRHS Staff membersApplications for this scholarship are in the Student Services' Office. Completed applications with attached letters of recommendation and other requested information should be returned to Mr. Greene by March 12, 2010. Mr. Greene will verify GPA requirements and SAT scores and mail the applications.
2. **Raleigh Mayor's Committee for Persons with Disabilities Scholarship** - This award is open to any senior who has a documented disability (IEP or 504 Plan) and has been accepted to attend either a four-year college or technical school. Applications are in the Student Services' Office, and the deadline to apply is May 28, 2010.
3. **Bob McGuire Memorial Scholarship** - This award is sponsored by the N.C. Child Support Council. Applicants must have at least one parent who is a member of the N. C. Child Support Council or be a client of the Child Support Program. Applications are in the Career Center, and the deadline to apply is April 16, 2010.
4. **NC Society of Accountants Scholarship** - This \$500 scholarship is for any senior planning to study accounting in college. Applications and instructions are in the Student Services' Office. The deadline to apply is April 15, 2010.
5. **Capital Area Bowling Scholarship** - This scholarship is open to seniors who are members of the Capital Area USBC or whose parents are member of the Capital Area USBC and have at least a 2.5 GPA. Applications can be found at www.raleighbowling.com, and the deadline to apply is April 6, 2010.
6. **State Employees' Association of North Carolina (SEANC) Scholarship** - There are several scholarships available to students whose parents are members of SEANC. There are scholarships available based on academic merit and financial need. Applications are available at www.seanc.org, and the deadline to apply is April 15, 2010.
7. **Capital Area Bowling Scholarship** - This scholarship is open to seniors who are members of the Capital Area USBC or whose parents are member of the Capital Area USBC and have at least a 2.5 GPA. Applications are in the Student Services' Office, and the deadline to apply is April 3, 2009.

8. **Wake NCAE Educator Scholarship** - This scholarship is for seniors who are planning on majoring in education in order to be a classroom teacher. Applicants must have a parent who is a member of Wake NCAE, and the scholarship is based on academics, school and community activities, special recognition, and professional involvement in Future Teachers of America and/or the Teacher Cadets. 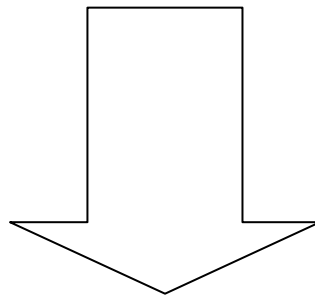
