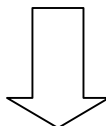


Scholarship Bulletin

March 2008

IF A SCHOLARSHIP REQUESTS THAT YOU MUST INCLUDE A TRANSCRIPT WITH YOUR APPLICATION, YOU MUST DO THE FOLLOWING: USE YOUR TRANSCRIPT RELEASE FORM ON FILE IN THE GUIDANCE OFFICE TO REQUEST AN OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT TO BE MAILED TO THE ADDRESS SUPPLIED IN THE SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION. THE REGISTRAR CAN GIVE YOU AN UNOFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT ALONG WITH A LETTER STATING THAT AN OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT WILL BE MAILED. YOU MUST PAY FOR THE TRANSCRIPT TO BE MAILED IF YOU HAVE ALREADY USED YOUR THREE FREE TRANSCRIPT REQUESTS. **DO NOT BRING YOUR REQUEST TO THE REGISTRAR ON OR NEAR THE DUE DATE AND EXPECT IT TO BE MAILED BY THE DEADLINE. YOU MUST ALLOW 5-7 DAYS FOR THE TRANSCRIPT TO BE MAILED.**

1. **The Miss Margaret Scholarship**-This award is open to any girl, who has been accepted at a four year college, has a minimum of 1000 (Critical Reading and Math) on the SAT and is in the top 10% of the senior class. Applications are in the Career Center and the deadline to apply is March 30, 2008
2. **Theta Nu xi Multicultural Sorority, Inc.** Scholarship- This scholarship is for a graduating female student based on merit, character and leadership in the school and community. Applications and instructions can be found at www.xi-theta.org The deadline to apply is April 1, 2008.
3. **Alpha Delta Kappa Scholarship**- This scholarship is open to students who are in the top 25% of the senior class and have been involved with school and community activities. The application does require that you write an essay in the presence of a teacher, or counselor. You will need to make these arrangements on your own. The applications are in the Career Center and the deadline to apply is March 31, 2008.
4. **Delta Kappa Gamma Women Educator's Scholarship**-This award is for a female senior who plans to pursue a career in education. Applications and directions are in the Career Center files. Leesville can only submit two names for this award. Completed applications, requested materials and a resume in the same format as the one included in the senior guidance bulletin should be returned to Mr. Greene by March 14, 2008. Once the two nominees are selected, official transcripts will be taken care of by Mr. Greene. Do not mail them on your own. You have to be selected by the school.
5. **Leesville PTSA Scholarships**- The PTSA is offering two \$500 scholarships to Leesville seniors. The criteria for both are listed below:
PTSA School Involvement Scholarship
 - 2.5 or above weighted GPA
 - School involvement
 - One teacher recommendation
 - Completion of an essay (topic is included on the application)



PTSA Academic Scholarship

- 3.7 or above weighted GPA
- School and community involvement
- One teacher recommendation
- Completion of an essay (topic is included on the application)

Applications for both scholarships are in the Career Center and completed materials must be returned to Mr. Greene by March 28, 2008.

- 6. Wake NCAE Education Scholarship**-This scholarship is for seniors who are planning on entering the field of education. Applicants must be the children of Wake NCAE members. Applications can be found at www.wakencae.org under the membership benefits heading. The deadline to apply is March 28, 2008.
- 7. Pride Productions, Jerry Mohs Theatre Scholarship**- Pride Productions is offering this \$1000 scholarship to a senior at LRHS who have had previous Leesville theatre experience and have plans to pursue further education in some area of theatre. Applicants must also have a minimum GPA of 3.0. Applications are in the Career Center and completed applications should be returned to Ms. Whitmire by April 28, 2008.
- 8. State Employees Association of North Carolina (SEANC) Scholarship**-There are several scholarships available to students whose parents are members of SEANC. There are scholarships available based on academic merit and financial need. Applications are in the Career Center and the deadline to apply is April 15, 2008.
- 9. Maude P. McInnes Award**-This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a Wake County Senior with a least a 2.5 GPA who is planning to attend a N.C. college, community college or tech school next year. Special consideration will be given to students seeking a career in family consumer science or a related field. Applications are in the Career Center and the deadline to apply is April 4, 2008.
- 10. Bob McGuire Memorial Scholarship**-This award is sponsored by the N.C. Child Support Council. Applicants must have at least one parent who is a member of the N. C. Child Support Council or be a client of the Child Support Program. Applications are in the Career Center and the deadline to apply is April 30, 2008.
- 11. Junior Women's Club Lynne Bedini Lewis Scholarship**- This scholarship is open to any senior planning to attend college in North Carolina and is based on Financial need, Character, Scholastic Record and Potential. Applications are in the Career Center and the deadline to apply is April 4, 2008.
- 12. Carrols Corporation Burger King Community Scholarship**- This scholarship is open to any graduating senior. Applications are in the Career Center and the deadline to apply is April 1, 2008.
- 13. GlaxoSmithKline Opportunity Scholarship**-This scholarship is available to any senior who has overcome adversity in their life. Applications can be found at www.trianglecf.org and the deadline to apply is March 15, 2008.
- 14. Brentwood Extension Home Economics Scholarship**- This \$500.00 scholarship will be awarded to a Wake County Senior with at least a 2.5 GPA planning to attend a N.C. College or tech school next year. Special consideration will be given to students seeking a career in home economics or a related field. Applications are in the Career Center and the deadline to apply is April 4, 2008.
