Pride Athletic Club Meeting Minutes, April 6, 2009

PAC President, Lee Foreman, called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Minutes – Minutes from the February 2, 2009 and March 2, 2009 were approved.

Treasurer's Report – Jay Wooten, Treasurer, presented the Summary of Financial Activities for 2009 through March 31, 2009.

Jay noted that some summer camp registrations had been received. Discuss began on the cost of summer camp facilities. Mr. Lyons signed a request for an in-kind donation for facility fees.

Per PAC procedures, a check for a portion of our annual membership funds is donated to Leesville Road High School. This year's portion is \$26,708.40 and has been presented to the school.

The method for distributing camp brochures was discussed. It was decided to distribute brochures to West Millbrook, LRMS, Durant, Jeffreys Grove,

TFS, York, Sycamore Creek, Baileywick, Hilburn, and Magellan. PAC members took forms to give to designated schools.

Concessions – Kim Fitzsimmons reported that the health inspector wants to inspect the outside concessions again. There doesn't appear to be anything wrong. It's surmised that he is new, and therefore, wants to redo it before the current inspection expires. His phone number is 857-9423. AD Jack Rogers noted that the outside concessions are clean. Kim said that it might be time to order sodas again.

Programs/Sponsors – April Lyon reported that 30 spring programs were ordered and would be going to the printer tomorrow (April 7th). April thanked the LHS yearbook staff for recording the names of the athletes for the pictures in the absence of other volunteers.

Membership – Sallie Burns discussed plans for PAC's assigned day for teacher appreciation festivities. Our assigned day is Friday, May 8th, and we will set up refreshments in three locations. Volunteers are needed to provide desserts that day. Sallie will send out a request to the membership list.

Athletic Director – Jack said that discussion on increasing the football ticket price to \$7 is tabled for now. He is researching ticket prices in other conferences for comparison, but thinks the price may end up being \$6.

He has received approval to hire a volleyball coach and will begin the hiring process. Leesville is also looking to hire a women's tennis coach and JV boys' basketball coach. A waiver will be needed to hire the basketball coach.
