Pride Athletic Club Meeting Minutes, August 10, 2009

PAC President, Lee Foreman, called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Minutes – Minutes from the June 1, 2009 meeting were approved.

Programs – April Lyon announced that the Fall Sports Program would be printed in black and white this year in an effort to reduce costs. She is getting estimates from another printer who specializes in black and white printing. She is still having a difficult time obtaining sponsors. Lee offered to ask Leesville Tap Room and Jay will ask Manchester's and Ben's Place.

Treasurer's Report – Jay Wooten presented the Treasurer's Report for the month ending July 31, 2009. This was Jay's last report as Treasurer.

The CD that just matured was cashed out and put in the Money Market Fund (\$29,000). Jay recommended that it be deposited into a new CD with a shorter time until maturity, setting aside approximately \$10-12,000 of that toward the fund for a new activity bus. Jay noted that net camp funds were approximately \$6500, less than last year. He plans on filing taxes this week.

Spirit Wear – Mikki Hawkins will be in charge of spirit wear this year. PAC approved \$1000 for initial expenses to purchase items.

Concessions – Concession area has been cleaned thoroughly and supplies are plentiful. The need for pizza warmers was discussed. By law, we have

to have an effective way to keep the pizzas warm. PAC approved the purchase of two pizza-warming boxes for \$70 each. Schiano's will purchase them for us.

A procedure for purchasing and reimbursing Football Moms for supplies was discussed. Two debit cards for PAC were recommended, with one for the Treasurer and one for Tracey Foreman (Football Moms). Martha Radulovich (09-10 Treasurer) and Tracey will meet to devise a procedure for the purchase of concession supplies and payment to Football Moms.

PAC Athletic T-shirts – Jay has some left over from last year. He will inventory them and then we will be able to determine how many additional ones to order. PAC voted that this year's shirt color be green.

Membership – Sallie Burns and Donna Davis announced that they will be selling memberships at the Pigskin BBQ on August 18th and the Open House on August 20th, setting up at 5 p.m. for those families that arrive before the 6 p.m. start time.

Athletic Needs List – PAC reviewed the athletic needs presented by Jack Rogers at the last meeting. The two defibrillators have been purchased and are in place. PAC approved the following expenses from that list: coaches attire for approximately \$1500; screening in front of the stadium – extending it for the entire length – up to \$1100; stanchions up to \$1000; cheerleading mat up to \$1000. Lee will ask Jack Rogers to obtain estimates for the equipment room storage system, storage building, concrete around baseball field bleachers, and the three-foot brick wall and backstop for baseball field before PAC is able to approve any additional expenditures.
