Pride Athletic Club Meeting Minutes, August 31, 2009

PAC President, Lee Foreman, called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

Minutes – The minutes from the August 10, 2009 meeting were approved with the following correction: changing the CD number to \$21,700 from \$29,000.

Membership – Sallie Burns reported a total \$31,141 in memberships received to date, with 196 of them family memberships and 53 individual. She and Donna Davis plan to sell memberships on Spirit Days and at home football games. All past PAC presidents were given PAC passes at no charge.

Treasurer's Report – Martha Radulovich, Treasurer, announced that letters requesting payment were sent to all parents whose checks for summer camps were returned for insufficient funds. She requested these parents reimburse PAC for the bank charges also.

The rebate request form (\$200) for the defibrillator has been submitted for reimbursement. New forms for deposits and check requisitions are on the LRHS website.

After some discussion, a motion made by April Lyon to change PAC's fiscal year from August 1st-July 31st to a calendar year was tabled until our October meeting. Jay Wooten, past Treasurer, will check to make sure that change would not hurt PAC's finances or tax status.

Concessions – The pizza warming boxes have been received and are in the concession stand. Chick-Fil-A bills us once a month and Schiano's comes through PAC's debit card.

Lee stated the procedure for concession money handling. The money from each home game is counted and deposited within 48 hours. More quarters are needed and other start up cash needs adjusting due to the football ticket price change to \$6 this year.

Two carts to tote cheerleading mats were purchased. One will be taken to away games. Athletic t-shirts have been received and are being distributed to coaches.

Programs – April Lyon announced \$4100 more in sponsorships has been given to Martha to deposit. The program is at the printer and will be ready next Tuesday to proof. Printer waiting on Lifetouch's photo CD before it can complete the program. The printer has guaranteed that they will be ready to sell by the first home football game. We could not switch printers as the three April called to submit quotes did not return her calls.

April is still waiting on coaches' information. She needs them by tomorrow in order to go into the program. She has ordered 250 fall programs and plans on selling them for \$5 if the program's quality merits that.

Athletic Wish List – Jack Rogers, AD, thanked PAC for the defibrillators and the stanchions, which have been ordered (10). PAC had agreed to pay for eight, and LRHS will pay for the extra two. Jack is waiting for quote for the baseball backstop. Quotes for concrete, equipment room, and storage room have not been requested. Windbreakers for coaches will be ordered by Friday.

Three tennis nets have been ordered. Shade for players discussed. April remembered that PAC previously approved two cabana tents and will investigate if they were ever purchased.

Events – September 11th is Coaches Night and October 2nd is Sponsor Night. Chick-Fil-A will donate food for both events, but additional food donations needed. Johnny Carino's and Westgate Deli were mentioned as possible donors. It was noted that the Ale House locations have expressed a desire to help schools. Lee will ask a representative if they would be willing to donate equipment, but it must be new. (Old/used equipment presents a liability issue for Wake County Schools.)

Announcements – Lisa Boneham announced that volleyball parents are going to sell concessions at their home games.

Fran Wilson is helping Mikki Hawkins with spirit wear and said they need approval to order thundersticks. Mr. Lyons will have to be consulted. Fran and Mikki are open to other ideas to show school spirit at athletic events. Suggestions included: recycled pompoms, bandanas, glo-sticks, spirit towels, and 'Livestrong' bracelets.
