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Pride Athletic Club Meeting Minutes, December 11, 2006

Meeting started at 7:10pm

Minutes from June meeting read by Jackie Saxton

Treasurers report read by Fred Wollman (As of 12/11/06)

Checking: \$21,793.98

Money Market: \$64,989.90

Bus Fund: \$20,371.98

Total: \$107,155.86

Fred also reported that the concessions made a total net amount of \$27,705.00. He had also contacted all the sponsors of the golf tournament, and he will keep all the checks for the make-up date which was a total of \$2,800

Old minutes and treasurers report approved.

Spirit Committee: Fred Wollman reported that the Wooten family donated \$400 to the spirit committee, that amount was applied to the \$750 approved at the last meeting.

Throws: Another 30 throws have been ordered, of those approximately 25 are already sold

Bricks: \$650 has been collected equaling 13 new bricks. Dr. Gainey stated that the goal of these bricks is to preserve Leesville history and we needed to come up with a consistent plan for placement and a good plan to market these bricks. PTSA will receive a portion of the proceeds minus what is owed to the PAC. Discussion took place regarding turning the brick program over to the PTSA, Misty Brazelton suggested coming up with a committee that would be represented by all "booster" groups to review the location/ placement of the bricks and splitting the funds. John will get with Misty to give her all the information. Karin Long suggested marketing to the senior class.

Concessions: Kim Fitzsimmons reported 43 people helped in the concession stand during the fall season, she has sent out 25 thank you notes to these families. There is a minor problem with the popcorn machine in the outside concession and is currently working on having it fixed. Inside concessions are going well; she is having some difficulty getting parents to work.

Newsletter: Misty Brazelton asked for a PAC representative to write an article for a section of the newsletter that goes out 4 times a year. John Lemanowicz stated that he would take care of writing the article.

Posters: Mark Slawson has posters with the same logo that is on the throws. We will order 100 posters and sell them for \$5-\$6.

Football: Coach Smothers asked for t-shirts for the varsity football team. GSK donated \$1000 through John Lemanowicz, and that money will be used to order these t-shirts. The Art department designed the t-shirts.

New Officers: John Lemanowicz asked for everyone to be thinking about candidates for the new officer roles for the 07/08 school year. John and Fred Wollman both stated that they will assist in the transition of these roles.

Summer Camps: Fred Wollman stated that the PAC will be looking for someone to take over the summer camp registrations. This takes 4 weeks in the summer and need to be available on Monday and Fridays during this time period to assist at the camps.

Wish List:

Tractor: Coach Hamilton discussed some options of a reconditioned John Deere for \$21,800; this will be discussed at the next meeting.

Softball Field: NWB is putting tops on and slabs, we will wait for the slabs to complete the fencing and windscreens. Would like to see this project completed by the 07 spring season, NWB does have a deadline to get this completed. Fred Wollman will follow up with NWB.

Baseball Field: A motion was made by Fred Wollman and seconded by Nanci Lemanowicz for \$4,000 to add piping and netting screens for safety 4-5 feet out in front of the dugouts on the baseball field.

Maintenance program for the weight room: Discussion took place regarding setting aside a budgeted amount each year for weight room maintenance. We will discuss this further at the next meeting.

Bus CD: A motion was made by Nanci Lemanowicz and seconded by Karin Long to set aside \$10,000 for the bus CD fund.

Field Maintenance: Matt Wilson will contact Coach Hamilton regarding supplemental fertilization, weed control, top dressing and aeration.

Tunnel: Coach Hamilton asked that the tunnel on the football field be removed, April Lyon will be contacted to remove and a suggestion was made to store the tunnel under the bleachers.

Cheerleaders acknowledgement: A member of the varsity cheerleading squad was present and expressed her thanks on behalf of the squad for all the support from the PAC this year and especially for the new mats.
