Pride Athletic Club Meeting Minutes, December 1, 2008

PAC President, Lee Foreman, called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Minutes – Minutes from the November 10, 2008 were approved.

Concessions – Kim Fitzsimmons reported that the Girls' Basketball team parents had done a good job at organizing their volunteer schedule for the concession stand. There is no schedule for the Boys' Basketball team as yet.

Lisa Potera (a cheer mom) helped Kim moved concessions on November 13, 2008. Kim noted that the outside concessions door was unlocked that day and another day.

Inspection of the outside concession stand occurred and passed. The inspector wanted to know why we didn't have warming bags for pizzas. The warmer may be acceptable for outside concessions but we may have to purchase a bag for the inside concession stand. Inspection of inside concessions is not due yet.

Treasurer's Report - Jay Wooten reported that PAC holds the following in its accounts:

The bill for the coaches' jackets is not reflected in this statement. Their cost was \$1206.28. Concessions has been the most active fund since last month.

The buses used for the football playoff game were subsidized by PAC in the amount of \$883. Holiday Tours was the company used although there was some discussion regarding one bus not having a working bathroom, and specifically questioning whether the bus driver knew about it prior to pick up. If buses are needed next year, another company might be called upon, or this incident mentioned in the hopes of adjusting our rate favorably.

Sponsors – Sponsor signs in the gym are not accurate. Two new signs are too big and need to be reordered. More than \$1200 has been paid for the most recent signs. If it costs too much to reorder, an option would be to obtain more plywood, paint it, and erect it so that the signs would fit. Lee will talk to April Lyon about that. Jack Rogers will remove the sponsor signs that have expired.

As to the possibility of acquiring a new printer for the programs, Lee is to have some more information by the January meeting. Perhaps we'd get a better rate if the same printer printed our summer camp brochures.

PAC Athletic Shirts – Jay has gotten a response on the number of shirts needed from all coaches except swimming and indoor track.

Open Positions – Lee mentioned the PAC positions that would need to be filled next year. Jay has to step down as treasurer, Kim will step down and we need a summer camp coordinator as soon as possible. Jay is hopeful that the ad he put in the latest Pride Post issue would yield some interest. Sallie will review the membership applications to see if anyone expressed an interest in volunteering.

Specifics of the Concessions Chair's duties were addressed. Kim is going to put some thought as to the best way to organize the position and the number of people needed for the position. Possibilities: one chair with a person to handle JV games, varsity games, each sport responsible for their own home game concessions, one person in charge of restocking, one person in charge of fall sports, one for winter and one for spring.
