**Programs:** Winter programs are still not in. John Lemanowicz will get the programs and give them out at no cost, since the winter season is almost complete. Coach Hamilton suggested that we give the coaches the programs to hand out at their winter banquets.

**Concessions:** Kim Fitzsimmons reported she has \$1,429 to turn in to Fred for a total of \$3,928 for indoor concessions. She has scheduled the cleaning of the outside concessions on 2-17-07. Lynn Kern will oversee the concessions for soccer. The Pepsi trailer will be here for the baseball field this coming Friday. Coach Hamilton will try to get the water turned on in the outside concessions by the end of the month.

**Golf Tournament:** The Golf tournament has been rescheduled for May 4<sup>th</sup> 2007. Nanci is working on getting more sponsors. The tournament is up on the Leesville website including registration. There are currently 60 golfers registered.

**Bricks:** We do have approximately 30 more orders for bricks. An order will be placed soon.

**Summer Camps:** All dates have been agreed for the camps and the brochure is ready for printing. We are holding off on printing and distributing the brochures until Julie Pennington completes the work on the camp website. We will be allowing on line registration with the ability to enter all information via our secure website. This will greatly reduce the work on gathering paper registrations and entering the data on spreadsheets. This will also allow us to send and email acknowledgement to each registered camper via email. Many thanks to Julie for the work. We will be in full swing with promotions and distribution by February 20<sup>th</sup>.

**Wish List:** Paperwork for the fencing and windscreens for the softball fields is all in and we are waiting on approval. Estimate came in at \$10,000 which is lower than expected. The Eagle Scout project for the softball field fell through due to costs. We will continue to look at the concrete for this area. Covers for the softball dug outs are being taken care of by WCPSS. There is a work order in to remove the carpet in the locker rooms. PAC will have some money still available to contribute to the wish list. Coach Hamilton and Dr. Gainey will continue to think about the items on the wish list and we will discuss at our next meeting.
