Treasurer's Report – In Jay Wooten's absence, there was no financial report.

Athletic Director – Jack Rogers has recommended the new Volleyball and Tennis coaches to be hired and is waiting on their approval from WCPSS. He is holding a meeting for students who are interested in playing these two sports to meet on Wednesday, July 29th at 6 p.m. to meeting the coaches and obtain information about trying out for these sports.

Membership – Sallie Burns and Donna Davis have received the new PAC membership cards (2000). All PAC related forms are almost complete for the next school summer mailing. They included: President's letter, sponsor

form, membership application and brick ordering form. Donna will take them to Office Depot for copying. At the Open House on 8/20, Mr. Lyons will make sure PAC has tables set up by 5 p.m. to sell memberships. Sales will have to be rotated, as PAC parents will want to participate with their child/children.

Athletic Needs List – Jack presented PAC with the Athletic Department’s needs for the year. PAC and Jack ranked them in order of importance. It was agreed that the defibrillators were critical now with some fall sports beginning the following week. Jack will obtain quotes and forward to PAC via email for final approval so he can place the order ASAP. Other needs are:

- Storage system for equipment rooms (bins, shelving, etc.) – no estimate
- Storage building between practice fields for tennis, football, training, and soccer – est. \$5000-6000
- Coaches’ shirts or windbreakers – est. \$1500 in 2008
- Screening on front side of stadium, bordering parking lot (Home of the Pride, www.ondecksports.com) - est. \$580 for 110’ at 9’ high (approx.)
- Concrete around baseball field bleachers - \$16,540 in 2008 by Werner Concrete, and \$16,714 by Concrete Solutions in 2008
- Three foot brick wall and backstop for baseball field – quote available soon
- Retractable belt stanchions – est. \$103.50 for each 7’ section. Estimated needing 8 of them, totaling \$828.
- One section of mat for multipurpose room – est. \$899.

Girls Soccer – Coach Dinkenor thanked PAC for its gift of warm jackets for each member of the girls’ soccer team in recognition of their state championship win.

Minutes – Minutes from June 1, 2009 meeting were approved with the correction of Tracey Foreman’s email address to TAforeman457@aol.com.
