Pride Athletic Club Meeting Minutes, May 4, 2009

President Lee Foreman called the meeting to order at 7 p.m.

Minutes – Minutes from the April 6, 2009 meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report – Financial statement for the month ending April 20, 2009 is as follows:

Jay reported that money had been collected for concessions from baseball and soccer games. Approximately 80 kids have registered for the summer camps. All the camps have been approved by Wake County except the field assignments for football and cheerleading. Bill Nolan will insert camp brochures in the golf tournament goodie bags. If the camps are not viable financially, we will consider canceling them.

Communities in Schools is the agency that coordinates the renting of school facilities. They charge for fields and the gym, as well as the use of bathrooms at the stadium. Jay is going to look into reducing or eliminating the charge for that.

Golf Tournament – Bill Nolan reported that 50 players have registered so far, down from approximately 80 last year. PAC discussed possibilities for the decrease and considered the economy and the tournament held on a Monday instead of a Friday. It was determined that we call beer, per the

ABC Commission, but Mr. Lyons will double check. Chick-Fil-A is sponsoring/providing lunch. Bill asked for a family PAC membership for the silent auction. Triangle Orthopedic provided 120 drawstring bags.

Programs – Per April Lyon, spring sports programs have been delivered. April proposed using a different printer for programs next year as the current one is becoming costly. She is going to determine who prints Campbell's programs because they are of high quality and not as expensive. They are sold for \$3.

President's Report – Lee Foreman has been approached by Drew Waite (sp?) who does the website. PAC discussed having him design one specifically for PAC so we can post scores, schedules, directions to games, etc. Mr. Lyons is going to talk to LHS' webmaster, Mark Mash about it. It should be a useful format if the each coach can log in and post scores. But it will only be truly useful if all coaches and staff use it optimally.

Teacher Appreciation – Sallie Burns reminded PAC that we are responsible for Friday's Teacher Appreciation goodies. We are setting up treats in two lounges and the front office as well as provide some for cafeteria staff.

Lacrosse Update – Jack Rogers reported that approximately 100 kids attended the interest meeting, but no final decision would be made until the forms were returned by the May 15th deadline.

Concessions – Discussion of concession duties continues. Lee presented a proposal by the football moms. Their proposal is that their group will run it during football season and take a 15% cut of the profits. Also discussed was the possibility of paying an outside company to run it for the entire year. April suggested the football moms consider running it for all sports. Lee to go back to them with that suggestion and PAC will discuss at the next meeting.

Treasurer – Donna Davis said that Martha Radulovich has agreed to be treasurer for the next two years. PAC voted to put her on the slate as treasurer and present the entire slate for a vote at the next meeting. Lee is going to make sure that the slate, positions and vote are presented to the Leesville parents.
