Pride Athletic Club Meeting Minutes, November 10, 2008

PAC President, Lee Foreman, called the meeting to order at 7:15 pm.

Minutes – Minutes compiled from October 6, 2008 meeting were approved.

Programs – Cost of the fall sports programs was discussed. They cost \$8 per program to print and were sold for \$3 each. Sallie Burns suggested that we contact other schools to see which printer they use to possibly reduce costs.

Treasurer's Report – Jay Wooten reported that PAC holds the following in its accounts:

Jay noted that revenue is down compared to the same time last year. The only money of note coming in now is from concessions. Treasurer Report was approved.

Dr. Gainey reported that the bill for the framing of Mr. Hamilton's portrait has been paid. Hunt Ward Photography did the work. The cost was \$299.97 and PAC will be reimbursed for this cost. Joe's Sign did the permanent sign and its cost was \$3235.63.

Per Jack Rogers and Jay, the training/athletic tables and coaches' jackets have been ordered.

Next Year Planning – Discussion opened for positions and their responsibilities for next year. It was agreed that Concessions needs a committee, headed by a chair, to coordinate concessions for sporting events. Parent reps for each team were recommended. A Summer Camp Coordinator is needed soon to begin planning for 2009 Summer Camps. This position entails meeting with coaches to set dates, print and distribute brochures, order t-shirts for the camps, and marketing the camps. It is unknown if we will need a new Treasurer yet. The possibility of having these positions advertised on the yahoo service was discussed. No decision.

Other suggestions included hosting a Bar-B-Que fundraiser in August/September to kick off the year for all sports and meet the coaches. Donna Davis is to contact someone at Sanderson who hosted one recently to see how their event.

Golf Cart – Donna presented research on obtaining a new golf cart. She talked to Chip Watson at Wildwood Green who informed her that they rent their carts. She also talked to EZ Go who said that they have used ones that can be traded for our old ones. He said that he would come by to look at ours to determine a trade in value. He needs the serial and model numbers. Jack to obtain that.

Concessions – Kim Fitzsimmons reported that she spent 5 ½ hours restocking concessions for basketball. Concessions to be deposited without counting those of last football game are \$6967. She hadn't counted the last game total yet but had taken \$160 out for start up cash and \$40 was spent on restocking. She needs help this week for basketball, wrestling, and the football game Friday (20 people needed for that). The need for more people involved with concessions next year was emphasized again.

Sponsors – Lee Foreman noted that some sponsor signs in the gym had expired and he would discuss with April Lyon.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:10 pm. The next PAC meeting is December 1, 2008 at 7 PM in the Career Center.
