## Pride Athletic Club Meeting Minutes, October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2006

Meeting started at 7:10pm

Minutes from August meeting read by Jackie Saxton

Treasurers report read by Fred Wollman (As of 10/30/06)

Checking: \$14,835.19  
Money Market: \$49,928.51  
Bus Fund: \$20,371.98  
Total: \$85,135.67

Fred Wollman also reported that the bids have come in on the 4 new glass goals for the side basketball goals at \$4,066 for the goals and \$1,200 installation for a total of \$5,266 from Johnson Lambe. These goals will help all students and summer basketball camps, however we will wait until the spring for these goals to be installed and they will be up in time for summer camp. The bids for the screens for the baseball and softball fields had also come in at \$2,040 for the baseball field and \$1,260 for the softball field a motion to accept this bid was made and approved. There was discussion about equally spreading the funds to all sports - Dr. Gainey talked about the girls softball fields and there are still no covers for the dug-outs. They have still been waiting on North Wake Baseball to follow through with this. Dr. Gainey suggested moving forward on our own with this. John Lemanowicz suggested we go ahead and get some bids for this with about a \$15,000 budget for the softball fields. We will discuss ongoing upkeep funds for the weight room at a later date.

Membership Revenue was reported by Fred Wollman: 2006 YTD = \$34,981  
2005 YTD = \$34,421

There have been 264 total memberships this year thus far and are expecting a few more to come in during Basketball and wrestling season.

Old minutes and treasurers report motion accepted and approved.

### Old Business

**Concessions:** Kim Fitzsimmons reported that concession have been very busy they brought in \$4,958 the last football game, she has made a \$8224.25 deposit. She has \$8,849.71 to give to Fred for a total of \$17,073.96 with 2 games to go. The popcorn machine has been ordered for the inside concession stand and should be here tomorrow, 10/31. Kim is looking for volunteers for the play off games. She is also looking in to a Pepsi trailer for the play offs to help meet the demand. There was discussion to put the

trailer on the visitor's side of the field for these games. Kim is putting a plan together for the inside concessions, games start Nov 14<sup>th</sup>. John Lemanowicz recognized Kim for the great job she is doing running concessions this year.

**Golf Tournament:** Nanci Lemanowicz reported that we need to pick a make up date for the golf tournament - we will look at May 4<sup>th</sup> and May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2007. Nancy will speak to Wildwood about these two dates. The question was asked what should be done with the sponsor's checks that had been received for the October 6<sup>th</sup> date. Fred will call each sponsor and let them know that we are rescheduling and ask what would they like done with their checks - they can be returned or deposited for the make up date in May.

**Spirit Committee:** Mikki Hawkins reported that she has spent her \$1,000 allowance that was given to her by the PAC, and requested more money for the playoff games. She is looking at foam "paws" and pom-poms - a motion was made and approved for an additional \$750 to be given to the spirit committee.

**Bricks:** John reported that plans are moving forward for the brick project. We are close to ordering another section, we need 25 for an order and are very close to that amount. Dr. Gainey discussed co-selling the bricks with the PTSA, it is a great fundraiser for preserving history at Leesville. John will speak to the PTSA president and report back.

**Throws** Throws are selling well and we will be ordering more.

### **New Business**

**Wish List:** Coach Hamilton requested looking at a maintenance program for the fields, John will talk to Matt Wilson about this. Also a possible request was discussed of upgrading the "PA" system at the football field.

**Recognition:** Dale Zagiba wanted to thank everyone in the PAC and also Leesville in general for everything that had been done for his family in the loss of his wife. Dale and Jennifer are very appreciative of everything.

**State Playoffs:** Coach Hamilton reported just a reminder that the State mandates a 7:30 start time for the football playoffs and that PAC passes are not valid for the playoff games. He requested a list from Kim and John of anyone that would be "working" the game that they could have at the gate.

Next meeting is scheduled for December 4th @ 7:00pm.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:30pm.
