Meeting Minutes, September 2, 2008

PAC President, Lee Foreman, called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm.

Minutes from the August 4, 2008 meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Jay Wooten reported that PAC had \$44,471.88 in PAC's checking account, \$29,652 in the MM account plus 2 CD's. We have an outstanding check from a past senior (Katie Burgess) from soccer camp this summer.

No word on the cost of shirts from Jack Rogers for the Coaches. (He was at a soccer game tonight).

Treasurer report was approved.

Concessions: Kim Fitzsimmons reported that the first home game went well. She gave Jay \$2403 to deposit. The new Pepsi trailer should be delivered and up and running by the next week JV home game. The Italian Ice guy will be at Thursday, September 4, 2008 game. She has tried to get a hold of Goodberry's, but hasn't gotten a response.

Terry Butler and Stacia from Chick Fil A attended the meeting and said they want to help more. They think that they are only doing about 30% of what they should or could be doing. They want to do something special on a home game. They are going to kick some ideas around to see what they can do to help us.

Membership: Sally and Donna were not at the meeting but forwarded the information to Lee. We are at 220 Family memberships and 59 individual memberships. As of 8/31/2008 we took in \$26,198 and they gave Jay another deposit to put us over \$34,000. Since the varsity game was moved to Thursday Sally and Donna have a conflict of having memberships available at the game so Lee said that he would do it.

Sponsors: April Lyon reported that sponsorship was down this year as of 8/31/08 she had collected \$8325. She also reported that the printers

should have the programs ready by next Friday, September 12, 2008.

April asked Dr. Gainey if she could do a special cover for the naming of the stadium this fall. He said that would be a great idea. Since our home games are limited April suggested either to do sponsor night at another sport or another season, but after thinking about it, everyone agreed that we should do sponsor night on October 10th, 2008 since there was going to be a lot of people there for the naming of the stadium.

Spirit Committee: PTSA is now in charge of all LOONIES t-shirts. Lee reported that the PAC athletic t-shirts were in and we were just waiting on the coach's order forms. Jay is following up on those. Lee said that Fran was going to look into license plates brackets.

A golf parent asked if PAC could or would invest in a golf practice machine. Cost is approximately \$7,000. We told her that it had to go through the proper channels before we could do something like that. Also last year the PAC club said that we need to get practice buckets of balls for all the golf matches and she informed us that she only received a \$26 check for state practice balls. We need to discuss this at the next meeting.

We agreed to purchase the framing for Ann Hamilton's gift.
