

President's Volunteer Service Award at Leesville Road High School For Volunteer Work performed during the School Year of 2010 - 11

Students who volunteer 25 hours or more are eligible for the President's Volunteer Service Award. We know our students are working to meet the needs of their community, and the PTSA is proud to help them achieve this award.

This program was established in 2003 by the President of the United States, to honor individuals, families and groups. The Award is issued by the President's Council on Service and Civic Participation. Our LRHS PTSA participates to honor our students.

Because our PTSA has registered as a group, a student can qualify for an award with 25 hours of service in one school year. With that amount of volunteer hours, the recipient will receive a letter of congratulations from the LRHS PTSA and a Presidential lapel pin.

There are also higher levels, starting with 100 hours. Depending on the level achieved, students will receive all or some of the following:

- An official President's Volunteer Service Award lapel pin
- A personalized Certificate of Achievement
- A congratulatory letter from the President of the United States

Volunteers submit a record of their service hours to LRHS PTSA, and we will verify the service and present the award when received. The only requirement is that the necessary hours be completed within the stated 12-month period (August 1, 2010 – July 31, 2011). Recipients can qualify for a new award each school year. There are several categories within the program and these are given below. An application form is posted on the Leesville website under "Parent Groups", then "PTSA", then "Forms". Please return the completed form to Leesville Road High School, marked "PTSA/Presidential Volunteer Service Award" by September 1, 2011.

Students qualifying for the work during their 2010-2011 school year will be honored at a PTSA event at LRHS, date to be announced.
