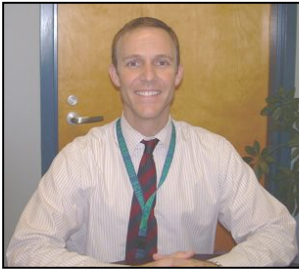

Principal's Corner

Happy Holidays! We are currently gearing up for first semester exams and second semester courses. Second semester schedules were sent home in the middle of January and report cards will be sent home with students on Friday, January 27.

On Tuesday, January 10, we will have a first semester awards day program in all classes. All teachers will recognize students in each class in the following two categories: *Students' Choice Award* and *Highest Academic Average*. The *Students' Choice Award* recipients will receive a pennant and the *Highest Academic Average Award* recipients will receive a

certificate. Congratulations to all of our students who receive awards.

The first semester exam schedule is as follows: January 12 – 1st period exam and 2nd period review, January 13 – 2nd period exam and 3rd period review, January 17 – 3rd period exam and 4th period review, January 18 - 4th period exam, and January 19th and 20th – make-up days.

Counselors will be meeting with groups of students and classes over the next couple of months to get them ready to register for the 2012-2013 school year. Since Hilburn Drive Academy will be adding a middle school to their existing elementary school and will be offering Chinese, we are currently in the process of adding Chinese to our course offerings. It is possible that we will be able to start building our Chinese courses for next school year. However, it will depend on interest as to when we start offering this new world language.

Winter has arrived. Any time there is a chance for snow, ice, or freezing rain, please make sure you pay attention to the news stations and/or the WCPSS website to see if schools will operate on a delay or be closed altogether. If the school is closed, then it is automatically a teacher workday. If you need to visit the school for any reason on a day that school has been canceled due to weather, please call the main number to make sure the building is able to be opened. If there is bad weather anticipated, I will leave an outgoing message on the main number (870-4250) if there is a delay or closing. So, if you do not have access to the Internet, television, or radio, you can call the school to check the status of school.

The Wake County School System has adopted a new student assignment plan. This is a choice plan and we have added some open houses to share the programs and activities available at our school to help recruit students. On Monday, December 12, we had an enrollment open house for all non-WCPSS students interested in Leesville Road High School. In addition, we will hold a recruitment open house with all of our feeder schools (Brier Creek Elementary, Jeffreys Grove Elementary, Leesville Road Elementary, Sycamore Creek Elementary, Hilburn Drive Academy, and Leesville Road Middle). The elementary schools will have displays set up in the cafeteria to highlight their programs and schools; and Hilburn Drive Academy, Leesville Road Middle, and Leesville Road High will give presentations in separate rooms. If you know of anyone interested in Leesville Road High School or one of its feeder schools, please encourage them to attend this open house to learn more about our great school. We have almost 400 open seats for next year, so there is room for new students.

We have had an outstanding school year so far and we look forward to a strong finish to our first semester. Go Pride!

This fall PTSA supported our school in several ways. We supported Staff Development through the purchase of two sets of books, *A Whole New Mind: Moving from the Information Age to the Conceptual Age* by Daniel H. Pink and *Mindset: The New Psychology of Success* by Carol Dweck, which will be used in book studies for the staff. We are also working with the staff to support them in a team building outing scheduled during a workday in the spring. LRHS PTSA joined with the middle and elementary school PTAs in bringing Seth Franco to our schools in November. All 9th and 10th graders participated in this program and the feedback was very positive. I attended his evening presentation for parents of all three schools and really enjoyed his presentation. Our Apparel Committee continues their tireless efforts to keep our students well dressed in LRHS PRIDE t-shirts, sweatshirts and other spirit wear. And no recognition of our fall activities would be complete without mentioning the Presidential Service Awards Ceremony in November. One hundred and seventy LRHS students were recognized for spending 19,096 hours volunteering. Our students do wonderful work in our community and we can be very proud of them. In total, students received one of these levels:

Gold - 17 people - 5187 hours total -- highest was Melinda Ewbank - 568 total hours

Silver - 27 people - 4901 hours total - highest was Samuel Freeze - 238 total hours

Bronze- 45 people- 5032 hours total - highest was Carlee Towns- 164 total hours

Standard - 80 people - 3976 hours total - highest was Sean Dutcher - 100 hours and Adam Backshall at 100 hours

Happenings in Student Services

- On November 17th, the counselors assisted approximately 50 seniors in applying to college during CFNC College Application Week.
- In the Spirit of the Holiday Season the Student Services Office has coordinated its second annual "Pride Pole". Organized by Brandy Lyons, Student Assistance Program (SAP) Counselor, the Pride Pole is a way for school staff to make some of our students' holiday season a little brighter. The students helped through this program are experiencing the loss of housing and the issues that come with being in this type of situation. School staff has so far selected 17 Leesville Lions from the Pride Pole. Each lion represents a student. Lions have been 'adopted' by individual staff, groups of teachers, departments, and a few clubs who are completing service projects. The gifts will be picked up or delivered to families before the Winter Break.
- Philomena Karol, counselor for students A-D, presented at a state wide conference for Career and Technical Education teachers on December 1. Ms. Karol, along with LRHS teachers, Angie Stephenson and Rick Hardy, presented strategies for differentiating instructions to meet the diverse needs of students. Ms. Karol works closely with the yearlong English I and Microsoft Word class that are taught by Ms. Stephenson and Mr. Hardy.
- The Counselors assisted with an Enrollment Open House on Monday December 12. This Open House is offered to families from outside the Wake County School System, who are considering LRHS as their school choice for 2012-2013. New Scholarship Announced

Leesville Road High School has announced a new, prestigious scholarship in honor of its founding principal, Richard J. Murphy. The fully endowed scholarship will begin this 2011-2012 school year by honoring two Leesville Road High School seniors as a Murphy Scholars. Each recipient will receive a \$2,500 scholarship.

A group of former Wake County principals, current and former Leesville teachers and staff, former Leesville students, and members of the Leesville business community came together to honor Mr. Murphy's legacy since his passing in March of 2011. As the first principal of Leesville Road High School, Mr. Murphy launched a school committed to high

standards for teachers and students and dedicated to exemplary performance in all aspects of curricular and extra-curricular activities. The Murphy scholarship intends to recognize a Leesville Road High School senior who embodies the high expectations and commitment to visionary leadership, service, and lifelong learning that Mr. Murphy epitomized and inspired others to achieve.

Mr. Murphy quickly became known within the Leesville community for his enthusiasm and tenacious work ethic. He is responsible for shaping every aspect of the school, from the building design, mascot and school colors, to the top-notch faculty and staff. True to its founding, Leesville Road High School has been one of the top-tier high schools in the state, consistently earning recognition for its academic, arts, and athletic programs. From the time North Carolina began its ABC accountability program in 1998 until Murphy retired as principal in 2004, Leesville's proficiency score rose every year, with a cumulative rise from 77.8 to 91.0. Because of these academic gains, Leesville received commendation from the ABC program every year during Murphy's tenure.

Dr. Stephen Gainey, who served as an assistant principal under Mr. Murphy at Leesville Road High School and succeeded him as principal, is now the Assistant Superintendent for Human Resources in the Wake County Public School System. Gainey said that Mr. Murphy's influence "will forever be present." He praised Mr. Murphy's impact on "the development of teachers and leaders in public schools. It was an honor to learn from an individual who truly was a 'star' as a principal. I will never be able to place a value on the tremendous amount of guidance and support provided by Mr. Murphy."

One of the teachers he influenced is Jennifer Faccolini, 2010 NC Teacher of the Year, who taught Social Studies at Leesville. She remembered once having a conversation with some co-workers about the high rate of attrition among beginning teachers. "What made you stay?" she was asked. Her answer was simple. "Leaders like Mr. Murphy. Mr. Murphy defined leadership and mentoring for me. He led by example and always knew how to ask the right questions to help me discover the teacher within me," she said.

Murphy began his education career as a teacher at Carnage Junior High and later Broughton High School. He went on to serve as an administrator at East Wake and Sanderson High Schools before being selected to open Leesville Road High School in 1993. After his tenure at Leesville, Murphy also served as the Wake County Director of Secondary Programs. He also served as the President of the North Carolina High School Athletic Association and sat on the Board of Directors for that organization. Before and after his retirement, he mentored future and current principals and served as a consultant to schools to increase student achievement.

The Richard J. Murphy Scholarship Fund has partnered with the North Carolina Community Foundation to collect and invest funds for this scholarship. The scholarship committee expects to raise \$250,000 to fully fund the scholarship which will support each recipient for four years. Thus far, \$160,000 in funding has been pledged by various stake-holding groups who support this effort. They are also seeking donations to fulfill and sustain the endowment.
