Dear Students and Parents/Guardians:

I hope you are enjoying your summer vacation! In a couple of weeks, you will be arriving at Leesville Road High School for the opening of school. We are excited about the new school year and anticipate a great year ahead.

We are enclosing your schedule of classes for the first and second semester. We have made every effort to schedule students according to the registration sheets that were submitted in May. We want student schedules to be as accurate as possible by the first day of school to minimize interruptions to instructional time.

Please review your schedule, which is enclosed in this mailing. We WILL NOT be moving students out of courses that were selected on their registration sheets. Due to budget reductions for the 2009-2010 school year, almost all of our classes are full. The Leesville Road High School summer staff has worked hard to create a master schedule that will accommodate the requests made on the registration sheets submitted by students in May 2009. Please review your schedule, which is enclosed in this mailing. **Changes to schedules will be minimal and will only occur if there are errors or if you are assigned to a class that was not on your elective registration sheet.** The only changes that we will be able to consider are listed on the enclosed *Schedule Change Guidelines* sheet.

The Fall *Meet the Teachers Open House* will be held on Thursday, August 20, 2009 from 6:00 – 8:30 PM for all parents as well as students new to Leesville Road High School. This open house will begin with a general information session in the main gymnasium, followed by an opportunity for parents to follow their child's schedule and hear from their child's teachers. This will replace the Meet the Teachers Open House usually scheduled in September.

The first day of school is August 25. Classes start at 7:25 and students should report to their first period class between 7:18 a.m. and 7:25 a.m. There will be a list of all students posted around the school with their first period room number printed next to their name. Students will receive a copy of their schedule in their first period classes.

Several important items/events and their corresponding dates are listed on the back of this letter. We're looking forward to seeing you and to having a wonderful school year!

1. **Off-Campus Lunch Pass:** Seniors and juniors may pick up a previously-requested lunch pass or apply for a lunch pass in the **multipurpose room** on August 20 from 5:00 p.m. – 6:30 p.m.
2. **Parking Pass:** Students may not park on campus without a valid LRHS parking permit. Students must have a valid, permanent N.C. Driver's License to purchase a parking permit. All students must use their assigned parking spaces starting August 25. The charge for parking on campus is \$170.00. All checks should be made payable to Leesville Road High School. Forms for requesting a parking pass were made available to all students through the July 10 mailing. Parking pass requests sent to the school by August 5 were processed and will be mailed soon. Students who are requesting a parking space and did not submit a form by August 5 should get a form from the LRHS website or main office. The completed paperwork should be submitted to the main office. Please be advised that there will be a 24 hour waiting period, so do not bring a vehicle to campus until your parking request has been processed and you have received your parking tag.
3. **Traffic:** The parking lots behind the school are reserved for students and selected staff members only. A single lane is used for entry to the student parking lot in the mornings. Entry to the parking lots behind the school is prohibited from 2:00 – 2:45 p.m. due to the students' use of both lanes to exit the campus during this time period. To park on campus during school hours, a valid LRHS parking permit must be displayed in a student's vehicle at all times. Students MAY NOT park on the circle or any of the driveways at any time.
4. **Lunch Prices:** Lunch prices for the 2009-2010 school year are \$2.00 for plate lunch and \$.40 for reduced price lunch.
5. **Bell Schedules:** The following bell schedules will be used on our campus in the absence of special events, such as assemblies, and/or delayed openings due to inclement weather.

6. **Bus Routes:** The bus routes for the 2009-2010 school year are enclosed in this mailing. Please make sure you know the route number of your bus. Buses are parked in the bus parking lot according to route numbers. The parking spaces for buses are labeled by route number. Students need to keep up with their route number, not their bus number. Bus numbers may change throughout the year; however, route numbers will remain constant. The Transportation Office may be reached at 508-9064 if you have any questions.
7. **Dress Code:** The WCPSS Dress code continues to be in effect. Examples of prohibited dress include exposed undergarments, sagging pants, excessively short or tight garments, bare midriff shirts, strapless shirts or ones with straps less than three fingers wide, attire with lewd/indecent/vulgar messages, head coverings of any kind, see-through clothing, and attire that exposes cleavage. The "no head gear rule" applies to all indoor activities during all hours.
8. **Dances:** Leesville Road High School prohibits students who have been suspended from school during the school year from attending any dances, including the prom, during the same year. Please be aware of this policy.
